



SA High Schools Championship CGGU Qualifier

30th June 2019

Kyalami Country Club

1. General Information:

- a. Entries from the Schools must be received by CGGU no later than Friday 21st June 2019.
- b. High school players must be at the school on a full time basis, between grade 8 and grade 12 of the year of competition. Players cannot be older than 19 years of age in the year of competition.
- c. A High school team will consist of 4 players.
- d. The SA High Schools Championship CGGU Qualifier will be decided over 18 holes of strokeplay.
- e. In the SA High Schools Championship CGGU Qualifier the best 3 stroke play gross scores will be added up and the school with the lowest overall total will be declared the winner.
- f. In case of scores being tied – the scores of all four players will be added together. The team with the lower total will be placed ahead of the other team that is involved in the tie, failing that the following procedure will determine the tie.
 - a sudden – death play –off between the number 1 player of each school on holes to be decided by the tournament organizing committee.
 - Should this method still not result in an overall winner a count out will be done between the number 1 players of the teams, if the scores are tied, a count out at nr 2, if the scores are still tied, a count out at nr 3 if the scores are still tied and, a count out at nr 4 if the scores are still tied. All these are done comparing each player's total gross score over the last 18 holes. If it is still impossible to declare a winner, the winning school will be determined by a toss of coin.
- g. All costs of the school playing in the SA High Schools Finals Championship will be for the expense of the school. The CGGU will provide a contribution towards those costs.
- h. Players will be allowed to play for the school he attends irrespective of where the player is handicapped. Players do not need to be a member of a club to participate in this event.
- i. As this is a schools event no provincial colours will be awarded. The players may represent the school in their respective school colours.
- j. The top school in the union qualifier will qualify for the National Finals to be played on 5th and 6th August at Koro Creek. CGGU will make a contribution towards the schools costs.

2. Entry

- a. Entry fee is **R800** per team this includes greenfees and halfway house.
- b. **Entries close at 12h00 (noon) on FRIDAY 21ST OF JUNE.**
- c. A school must complete an **entry form** and submit it along with the **proof of payment** to:
growgolf@cggg.co.za
- d. All information required in the entry form must be provided accurately, legibly and in full;
- e. The onus is on the entrant to ensure that their entry has been received by Provincial Union, in accordance with the Conditions of Competition outlined herein.

- f. The Entrant's Declaration, on the Entry Form must be signed by the appointed representative of the school. No telephonic or postal entries will be accepted;
- g. On no account will entry fees be refunded unless a team withdraws prior to the closing of entries.
- h. All entries shall be subject to the approval of CCGU and SAGA who reserves the right to refuse any entry without giving reason. The decision of CCGU and SAGA as to the acceptance or refusal of any entry shall be final.

3. Rules of Golf

- a. The Tournament will be held in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the R&A Rules Ltd, the SAGA's Permanent Local Rules ('**Hard Card**') and Additional Local Rules approved by the SAGA. Copies of the Additional Local Rules are available from the SAGA at the tournament venue. All entrants are advised to familiarize themselves with these Additional Local Rules.
- b. **List of Conforming Golf Balls** (visit www.randa.org for latest listing)
- c. The ball the player plays must be named on the Current List of Conforming Golf Balls issued by the R&A. *Penalty for breach of condition:* Disqualification
- d. **List of Conforming Driver Heads** (visit www.randa.org for latest listing)
- e. Any driver that a player carries must have a clubhead, identified by model and loft that is named on the current List of Conforming Driver Heads issued by the R&A. **Exception:** A driver with a clubhead manufactured prior to 1999.
- f. **Penalty for carrying but not making stroke with club or clubs in breach of condition:* Stroke Play – Two strokes for each hole at which breach occurred; maximum penalty per round, four strokes. In the event of breach occurring between the play of two holes, the penalty applies to the next hole. *Any club or clubs being carried in breach of this condition must be declared out of play by the player to his marker or fellow-competitor in stroke play immediately upon discovery that a breach has occurred. If the player fails to do this, he is disqualified.
- g. *Penalty for making stroke with club in breach of condition:* Disqualification.

4. Transportation

- a. Players and their caddies must not ride on any form of transportation during a stipulated round unless authorized by a referee. Penalty: two strokes on each hole at which breach occurred; maximum penalty four strokes. In Stroke Play – In the event of a breach between the play of two holes, the penalty applies to the next hole. Use of any form of unauthorized transportation must be discontinued immediately upon discovery that a breach has occurred. Otherwise the player is disqualified.

5. Dress Code

- a. Players are required to comply with the prescribed dress code of the host club. Any player not conforming to these dress codes will disqualify themselves from participating and therefore will be told to leave the golf club until such time that they conform to these dress codes.
- b. To avoid any embarrassment to all concerned, please if unclear clarify the matter with the host club.

6. Practice

- a. To practice prior to the tournament, competitors must call Kyalami Country Club and book a round, subject to availability, on tel: **010 594 0034** during office hours. Any practice round is for the players/schools account.

7. COMPETITION RULES:

- a. Tee-off and draw will be available from the website www.cggu.co.za, and will be e-mailed to participating schools
- b. **Note:** It is the player's responsibility to ascertain his tee-off time beforehand and to report on time.
- c. **Boys to play off white tees and girls to play off red tees.**
- d. **Caddies:** Caddies are available and need to be arranged with the host club and paid for by the individual player.
- e. **Note:** Parents, friends & family to stay at least **40m** away from Players and must not interfere with play. No rulings or advice to players must be given, verbally or by hand signals.
- f. **The use of cell phones, mp3 or iPods is strictly forbidden during play.**
- g. Players may use distance measuring devices that conform to the Rules of Golf.
- h. Halfway House will be grab-n-go and is included in the entry fee, should a player wish to take something else or additional, this will be for their own account.

8. Exemption of Liability:

- a. The Host Club, the Central Gauteng Golf Union and their management will not be held responsible for any damages, loss, including
- b. Personal loss and or other forms of loss, harm or injury sustained as stipulated below:
- c. Physical and/or emotional injuries suffered during the tournament/championship, due to any acts of God, suffered as a direct result thereof, including aspects such as being struck by lightning, etc.
- d. Physical injuries of any kind suffered by any person, including a player or spectator sustained by own negligence, or otherwise.
- e. Emotional injuries sustained due to any loss, including death, suffered as a result of any of the above injuries sustained personally or by a spectator.
- f. Damages suffered to any property of a player.
- g. The appointed representative of the school acknowledges the exemption of liability of the Union and its management as listed above when he signs the acknowledgement. He also acknowledges the contents of the above, understands it, and exempts the Host Club and Union from any liability as indicated above.

The Host Club and Union does not warrant or guarantee the safety of any person.

For the School that qualifies for the SA High Schools National Final, all costs will be for the school's account. CGGU will make a contribution towards those costs
