

# THE PROSHOP NORTHERN AMATEUR TOURNAMENT RISK MITIGATION PROCEDURE

<b><u>Conditions of Entry:</u></b>	Participation to be subject to agreement and implementation of SA Government Regulations / Directions, GolfRSA Good Golf Practice Guidelines and the host facility's Risk Mitigation Plan (RMP) and this Tournament Risk Mitigation Procedure (TRMP).
<b><u>Entry and Payment:</u></b>	All entries and payments must be done through the online sign-up portal on the CGGU website to finalise your entry. No cash will be accepted at the event.
<b><u>Cancellations &amp; Withdrawals:</u></b>	If you have any of the Covid-19 symptoms on the morning before play or any time leading up to the event you are obligated to inform the Union and withdraw yourself from the event. In the case where you have already paid your entry fee the Union will refund your entry fee.
<b><u>Registration and screening:</u></b>	Players are required to comply with all club entry and screening processes. All persons accessing the facilities must divulge their Covid-19 status / honest account of symptoms at the screening station and subject themselves to sanitation and temperature screening as required (this could possibly be done on multiple occasions on site). Those with visible Covid-19 related symptoms or an elevated temperature of 38°C or more will not be allowed access to the venue and participants will immediately be withdrawn from the tournament. Players are then required to register with the CGGU team prior to teeing off
<b><u>Social Distancing and Wearing of masks</u></b>	Players must wear masks on arrival and in or around the clubhouse and when social distancing is not possible. On the course players may remove their masks if they keep a minimum of 3m apart, and 5m apart during windy conditions (>24km/h).
<b><u>Flagsticks and bunkers:</u></b>	Flagsticks will be allowed to be removed in the tournament. All pin flags and holes will be treated with the application of Zoono prior to the start of each round. This product will be re-applied daily prior to play (this application is to include the flag pole / flag and inside of the "cup"). Bunkers will be in play for the tournament and the rakes will be treated with an application of Zoono prior to the start of each round. All Players and Caddies must have the Germ24 product applied to their hands prior to the start of play (on the tee box prior to teeing off)
<b><u>Scoring and Markers</u></b>	Golfers may not share, or exchange scorecards. Golfers will be assigned scorecards on the tee box. After the round, the marker must confirm the score with the player verbally and verbally submit the scores to the tournament official at the scoring area. The player is not required to sign the scorecard.
<b><u>Caddies &amp; Transportation:</u></b>	Outside caddies will be permitted for the tournament  Players must walk at all times during a stipulated round, unless permitted to be transported on a golf cart by an appointed Rules Official or a member of the Tournament Committee.
<b><u>Prize Giving</u></b>	A small prize giving ceremony is to take place post the final round. Prizes will be sanitized prior to the ceremony and winners will pick them up from prize giving table. Any photos taken which can be associated with the tournament (pre/post round or during play) and displayed or shared comply with the applicable National Regulations and GolfRSA Risk Mitigation Guidelines. Photographs of prize winners shall be taken either individually (where the player may remove their mask provided, they observe physical distancing of 3m or more) OR for group photos (two or more people) either wearing a mask or maintaining physical distance of 3m or more. (Photos should not include any signs of physical touching e.g. Shaking hands)
<b><u>Spectators:</u></b>	Spectators - In terms of SA Government Regulations spectators are not allowed at GolfRSA and WAGR ranked tournaments.

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<b><u>Food &amp; Beverage</u></b>	All players/ caddies and tournament staff are to comply with the Rules and Requirements related to the catering facility and areas (including lounge areas) within the clubhouse and club grounds. Although these facilities may cater for sit-down meals, it is recommended however that player and caddie food and beverages be purchased on take away basis only, in order to avoid the congregation of persons in the clubhouse. All drinking fountains on the courses will be closed and players and caddies are advised to purchase their own bottled drinks and take enough with them on the course for hydration needs. The disposal of litter / food and beverage containers must be disposed of in a safe and tidy manner which may require such items to be carried from the course by the player/caddie and disposed of at the club house
<b><u>Exemption of Liability</u></b>	<p>The Host Club, Central Gauteng Golf Union and their management will not be held responsible for any damages, loss, including personal loss and or other forms of loss, harm or injury sustained as stipulated below:</p> <p>Physical and/or emotional injuries suffered during the tournament/championship, due to any acts of God, suffered as a direct result thereof, including aspects such as being struck by lightning, etc.</p> <p>Physical injuries of any kind suffered by any person, including a player or spectator sustained by own negligence, or otherwise.</p> <p>Emotional injuries sustained due to any loss, including death, suffered as a result of any of the above injuries sustained personally or by a spectator.</p> <p>Damages suffered to any property of a player.</p> <p>The Host Club and Union does not warrant or guarantee the safety of any person</p>
