



CENTRAL GAUTENG CADDY TEAMS SERIES CONDITIONS

2024

1) COMPOSITION

The series shall comprise of 4 caddies per team from each Club, with a maximum of 25 teams. A fixture list shall be drawn up by the C.G.G.U. The Caddy Teams Series is limited to clubs who are members of CGGU.

2) TEAMS SERIES FORMAT

The series shall be played over 4 matches and will start in March and end in September. Dates as per the fixture list. A draw will be done for each round and each team will be allocated their tee times. Failure for a team to arrive on time will result in disqualification.

3) DETAILS OF PLAY

- Play is to be conducted in accordance with the rules of golf.
- The competition format will be Stableford points played off the players HNA handicap and the winning team will be the best 3 scores from the 4 players. If a player does not have an official HNA handicap, the player will play off scratch. In the event of a tie, the 4th players score will be added to ascertain the winner.
- For the Overall Individual title and the Overall Team title all 4 rounds will count towards the overall total.
- If a club has entered more than 1 team, a player may not move from one team to the other during the season. The first match of the season determines your team. Replacements must be caddies who have not played a match yet during the season.
- Each team is to appoint a captain who is responsible for returning the teams scorecards and the collection of the teams travel allowance.

4) HOST CLUB RESPONSIBILITIES

There will be 4 venues during the year. Each Club will make their course available for the day and provide a halfway meal per player. The C.G.G.U. shall be responsible for funding of the above. Where a round cannot be played due to inclement weather conditions, the match will be cancelled.

5) PRIZES

Prizes to be awarded after each match played. Prizes will be awarded to the top three teams. There will also be prizes for the top three individuals. Prizes will also be awarded at the end of the series for the overall team and individual. In the event of a tie for overall winners, the score on the final round shall decide the winner.

6) GENERAL CONDITIONS

- a) An entry of R550.00 per team shall accompany applications to C.G.G.U.
- b) Visiting players must adhere to the host Club's dress code, also soft spikes regulations for the course.
- c) CGGU will contribute R50 per player for travel costs which the captain of the team will collect for the team.

The CGGU retains the right to impose such penalties for the non-compliance by any Club of any condition, as it may deem appropriate.
