THE FOLLOWING LOCAL RULES AND TOURNAMENT CONDITIONS ALONG WITH

THE GOLFRSA HARDCARD ARE TO BE USED FOR THE DURATION OF THE TOURNAMENT. GOLF

THE LOCAL RULES OF WANDERERS CC ARE HEREBY CANCELLED FOR THE DURATION OF THE EVENT.

PERMANENT CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION

- Suspension of Play Rule 5.7 applies. Once siren is sounded (One Long blast), all play MUST stop immediately. Any player who fails to comply and continue play, will be disqualified.
- Transportation Only permitted if approved by Referee
- Scoring Please return your scorecards to the scorer in the clubhouse directly after play. The whole clubhouse is deemed the scoring area.
- Closure of tournament the competition will be closed once the Final Results have been posted on the Live Scoring.

ADDITIONAL LOCAL RULES

PREFERRED LIES

When a player's ball lies in a part of the general area cut to fairway height or less the player may take free relief once by placing the original ball or another ball in and playing it from the relief area. The reference point is the spot of the original ball and the size of relief area, measured from reference point is **one club-length**, but must not be nearer the hole than the reference point, and must be in general area.

OUT OF BOUNDS AND COURSE BOUNDARIES (RULE 18.2)

Out of bounds is defined by the line between the course-side points at ground level of white stakes and fence posts. The clubhouse and paving surrounds are out of bounds.

NO PLAY ZONES

<u>Protection of Young Trees:</u> The young trees identified by a stake are no play zones: If a player's ball lies anywhere on the course other than in a penalty area and it lies on or touches such a tree and its basin/bowl or such a tree interferes with the player's stance or area of intended swing, the player must take free relief under Rule 16.1f.

PENALTY AREAS (RULE 17)

The red penalty area to the right of holes 5, 7, 9, 10 & 14 and beyond holes 8 & 13 extends to and coincides with the out of bounds edge.

DROPPING ZONES: As an extra relief option for the penalty area on holes 8 and 13 a drop zone is provided, by adding **one penalty stroke**, a player may drop a ball in the dropping zone marked in **red paint**. The dropping zone is a relief area under Rule 14.3.

PUTTING GREENS:

The practice putting greens located beyond the 9th and 18th holes are to be treated as wrong putting greens and relief must be taken under Rule 13.1f.

ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS (INCLUDING IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS) (RULE 16)

• Ground under Repair:

Ground under repair is defined by any area encircled by a white line.

• Integral Objects:

All flowerbeds are integral parts of the course.

All roads and paths unless artificially surfaced are integral parts of the course

Immovable Obstructions:

The halfway house located to the right of the 9th hole and behind the 7th is to be treated as an immovable obstruction.

PROCEDURE IN THE EVENT OF A TIE:

In the event of a tie for any division a count out will be done as per the rules of golf by matching of scorecards.
