

**THE FOLLOWING LOCAL RULES AND TOURNAMENT CONDITIONS ALONG WITH
THE GOLFRSA HARDCARD ARE TO BE USED FOR THE DURATION OF THE TOURNAMENT.**

PERMANENT CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION

- Suspension of Play – Rule 5.7 applies. Once siren is sounded (One Long blast), all play **MUST** stop immediately. Any player who fails to comply and continue play, will be disqualified.
- Transportation – Only permitted if approved by Referee
- Scoring – Please return your scorecards to the scorer in the clubhouse directly after play. The whole clubhouse is deemed the scoring area.
- **Closure of tournament – the competition will be closed once the Final Results have been posted on the Live Scoring.**

ADDITIONAL LOCAL RULES

PREFERRED LIES

When a player's ball lies in a part of the general area cut to fairway height or less the player may take free relief once by placing the original ball or another ball in and playing it from the relief area. The reference point is the spot of the original ball and the size of relief area, measured from reference point is **one club-length**, but must not be nearer the hole than the reference point, and must be in general area.

OUT OF BOUNDS AND COURSE BOUNDARIES (RULE 18.2)

Out of bounds is defined by the line between the course-side points at ground level of white stakes and fence posts. Beyond the palisade fences to the right and behind the 18th green.

When playing the **16th hole**, the bowling greens and tennis courts to the right of the 16th fairway and the area on the right of the 17th fairway demarcated with black and white stakes is out of bounds. (these black and white stakes are considered movable obstructions)

Relief from Electric Boundary Fence

If a player's ball lies on the course and within two club-lengths of the electric boundary fence, the player may take free relief under Rule 16.1, but based on the reference point that that is two club-lengths from the fence and an equal distance from the hole to the spot of the original ball.

PENALTY AREAS (RULE 17)

Where an artificial wall surrounds the edge of a dam or other body of water, the penalty area is defined by the outside edge of the wall on the course side (the wall is considered to be part of the penalty area and must be treated as such).

ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS (INCLUDING IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS) (RULE 16)

Ground Under Repair

- Ground under repair is defined by any area encircled by a white line.
- All flower beds.

Integral Objects

- All roads unless artificially surfaced are integral parts of the course.

Immovable Obstructions

- The halfway house and surrounds are Immoveable obstructions.

PROCEDURE IN THE EVENT OF A TIE:

In the event of a tie a count out will be done as per the rules of golf by matching of scorecards.
