

<u>Conditions of play:</u>	<p>Entries will be limited to 72 players based on the below conditions. The competition will be played under the Rules of Golf as approved by the R & A Rules Ltd and the Bye Laws and Local Rules as approved by the Central Gauteng Golf Union. The event is open to all amateur golfers who are members of a golf club affiliated to Central Gauteng Golf Union and who has a handicap index that meets the minimum requirements as listed below and is assessed in terms of the HNA Course Rating and Handicapping System.</p> <p><u>If more than 72 entries are received, the higher handicap index players will be eliminated by a handicap ballot based on your handicap index at the date and time of closing, such players will received a full refund of their entry fee. The union may impose a minimum number of places for lady and senior golfers who fall outside the handicap ballot to promote participation.</u></p>
<u>Format of Competition:</u>	<p>All tournaments will be played over 18 holes Stroke play. Divisions: Men's Midam (HI 4.0 and less) Men's Senior (HI 6.0 and less) Ladies Midam & Senior (15.3 and less) Men will play from the Traditional Club Tees and Ladies will play from the Ladies Tees. In the event of a tie for any division a count out will be done for prizes.</p>
<u>Entrance Fee :</u>	<p>R350-00 PAYFAST LINK <u>All payments to be done via the Payfast link.</u></p>
<u>Cancellations & Withdrawals:</u>	<p>Please note, any cancellations / withdrawals prior to the tournament will be charged a R30 cancellation fee. Any cancellations/withdrawals after the closing date, no refund will be due.</p>
<u>Closing Date:</u>	<p>Entries close at noon (13:00) as per the specific closing date listed for each event. Late entries and entries not through the online sign up process will not be considered.</p>
<u>Draw & Starting Times:</u>	<p>The draw will be conducted by the Central Gauteng Golf Union. The draw will be available on the Union's website (www.cggg.co.za) the Friday prior to the tournament. <u>It is the player's responsibility to obtain their tee-off time.</u></p>
<u>Decisions or Disputes:</u>	<p>The Tournament Organizing Committee are empowered to take decisions to resolve any dispute or impart the disciplinary code should this be necessary as regards behaviour unbecoming of that of a golfer.</p>
<u>Dress Code:</u>	<p>Only recognised golf attire that conforms to the dress code of the host club is permitted.</p>
<u>Transportation and Caddies:</u>	<p>No Travelling or outside caddies will be permitted, only local caddies may be used in the tournament. Breach of this condition will result in disqualification.</p> <p>The use of golf carts are also not permitted in the Midam Division for the duration of the tournament with the exception that officially certified Disabled Golfers may be exempted on a case by case basis (leg amputee for example) by the tournament committee. Certified Disabled refers only in this case to defective mobility and the use of a cart being granted. All requests should be made to the Tournament Director. Golfers in the Senior Division or Senior Ladies may use carts and these must be booked directly with the club.</p>
