

**THE FOLLOWING LOCAL RULES AND TOURNAMENT CONDITIONS ALONG WITH
THE GOLFRSA HARDCARD ARE TO BE USED FOR THE DURATION OF THE TOURNAMENT.**

PERMANENT CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION

- Suspension of Play – Rule 5.7 applies. Once siren is sounded (One Long blast), all play MUST stop immediately. Any player who fails to comply and continue play, will be disqualified.
- Transportation – Only permitted if approved by Referee
- Scoring – Please return your scorecards to the scorer in the clubhouse directly after play. The whole clubhouse is deemed the scoring area.
- **Closure of tournament – the competition will be closed once the Final Results have been posted on the Live Scoring.**

ADDITIONAL LOCAL RULES

- 1) **PREFERRED LIES**: When a player's ball lies in a part of the general area cut to fairway height or less the player may take free relief once by placing the original ball or another ball in and playing it from the relief area. The reference point is the spot of the original ball and the size of relief area, measured from reference point is **30 cm**, but must not be nearer the hole than the reference point, and must be in general area.
- 2) **OUT OF BOUNDS (RULE 18-2)**: beyond the fence bounding the course and any order areas marked with either white stakes and/or lines. The workshop and compound areas on the Bushwillow Course are to be treated as Out of Bounds.
- 3) **PENALTY AREAS (RULE 17)**:
 - a) All unmarked ditches to be treated as Red Penalty Areas
 - b) Where an artificial wall surrounds the edge of a dam or other body of water, the penalty area is defined by the outside edge of the wall on the course side (the wall is considered to be part of the penalty area and must be treated as such)
- 4) **ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS (INCLUDING IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS) (RULE 16)**
 - a) As defined in the Rules of Golf and any area ringed in white.
 - b) Protection of Young Trees. The young trees identified by blue stakes are no play zones and must be treated as an abnormal course condition. If a player's ball lies anywhere on the course and it touches such a tree or such a tree interferes with the player's stance or area of intended swing, the player must take relief under Rule 16.1f. Relief is extended to the bowl of a staked tree.
 - c) Flowerbeds and shrub gardens with a clearly defined margin, the player may take relief under Rule 16.1f
 - d) Powerlines: If it is known or virtually certain that a player's ball hit a power line during the play of [specify hole number], the player must replay the stroke by playing the original ball or another ball from the spot where that stroke was made (see Rule 14.6). This is only applicable to the power line and not the steel structure, the steel structure is an immovable obstruction.
